### Qualitative Data Analysis Presented by Dr Emily Hansen

Analysis is the process whereby qualitative data such as interview transcripts and field notes are transformed into research findings. Methods of qualitative data analysis are closely associated with theory and methodology. This workshop will give an overview of several commonly used approaches to qualitative data analysis. It is orientated towards people who are currently engaged in a qualitative research project or who are about to begin one. Participants are encouraged to bring along examples of their own analysis or data for discussion. The workshop will be run over two full days, a week apart. Participants will be expected to do 'homework' in the intervening week and some set reading prior to the workshop. **This is an intermediate PHCRED workshop, participants should have background knowledge about qualitative research**
